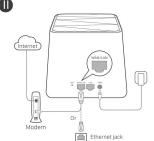

Install the Ultralink WiFi App

Download the Ultralink WiFi App on your mobile device by searching for Ultralink WiFi in App Store or Google Play or by scanning the QR code. Then, install the App.

Connect the primary node

*The first node you set up functions as the primary node. while the rest are referred to as the secondary node.

- 1. Use the included Ethernet cable to connect a LAN port of your modem or the Ethernet jack to the WAN/LAN port of any node. This node is your
- 2. Use one of the included power adapters to connect the primary node to a power source, the LED indicator lights solid on. Wait about for 40 seconds The system completes startup when the LED indicator blinks green.

Connect the primary node to the internet

- 1. Go to the WiFi network list on your mobile device, select the SSID of the primary node, and enter its password. The SSID and password are specified on the bottom label of any node.
- 2. Run the Ultralink WiFi App and follow the onscreen instructions to connect the primary node to the internet. After the primary node is connected to the internet, its LED indicator lights solid green

Connect the secondary node to the internet

- 1. Place each node
- At a high and open area within the network coverage of your primary node;
- Keep your nodes away from electronics with strong interference, such as microwave oven, induction cooker and refrigerator.
- 2. Use the other included power adapter to connect the secondary node to a power source, its LED indicator lights solid green. Wait about for 40 seconds. The secondary node is connecting to the primary node when its LED indicator blinks green.
- 3. Observe the LED indicator of the secondary node until it lights one of the following colors:

Solid green	Good connection	
Solid yellow	Fair connection	
Solid red	Disconnected	

4. If a node's LED does not light solid green, relocate it according to placement tips to get it better connected.

Done. To access the internet:

- -Wired devices: Connect wired devices to the LAN ports of your nodes
- Wireless devices: Connect wireless devices to your WiFi
- network using the SSID and WiFi password you set. If you want to manage the network anytime anywhere. tap (and use your account to login.

FAQ

Q1: How can I remove a node from my WiFi network? A1: Tap the node on the Ultralink WiFi App, tap ... in the upper-right corner, and choose Delete.

Note: Removing operation restores the node to factory

Q2: Can I add another new set of node to expand my network coverage?

A2: Yes, Run Ultralink WiFi App, tap Settings in the lower-right

Q3: How to restore my network to factory settings?

A3: With your nodes powered on, hold the RST button of your primary node down using a paper clip for about 6 seconds, release when the LED indicator blinks fast. Your network is reset successfully when the LED indicator lights solid on ther blinks fast again. And all nodes are restored to factory settings.

Q4: My 2.4 GHz WiFi-enabled devices, such as a home security camera, cannot connect to my UL-INT-MW3 WiFi network. What should I do?

- A4: 1. Connect your smart phone used for setup to your uL-INT-MW3
- 2. Run Ultralink WiFi App, tap Settings, Smart Assistant, and Enable. Your smart phone connects to the 2.4 GHz WiFi
- 3. Use the smart phone to set up your 2.4 GHz WiFi enabled device guided by its App.
