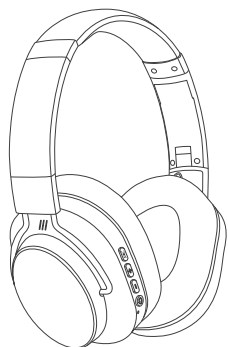

Symphonic Noise Cancelling Headphones

USER MANUAL

Congratulations on your purchase and thank you for your use of the Ultra-link Symphonic Noise Cancelling Headphones. Please read the instruction manual thoroughly before using this product.

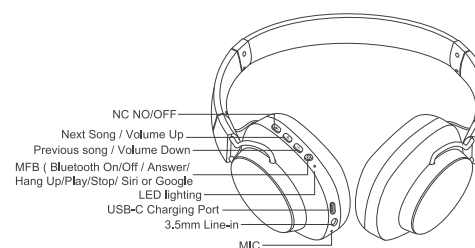
Caution:

1. Please switch off the headphones and put them into the packaging when not in use to avoid damage, scratches, or bracket deformation when the product is not in use.
1. Please charge the product before use if it was unused for a long time.
2. Do not disassemble this product or change its original battery.
3. Do not expose these headphones or any of their components to water, fire, high temperatures, or damp areas.
4. Store the product in a room-temperature environment. Do not place it in an environment above 60°C or expose it to fire as the battery might explode.
5. Do not bend or twist the product to avoid deformation.
6. Do not remove the ear cushions.
7. Do not use the headphones at an excessive volume or overnight as this can damage your hearing.
8. Do not use the headphones at an excessive volume in an environment where you cannot be aware of your surroundings as it may be dangerous.

What's In The Box:

This packaging contains the following:

- 1x Bluetooth Active Noise Cancelling Headphones
- 1x User Manual
- 1x Audio Cable
- 1x Charging cable



Charging The Battery:

A USB charging cable is included in the packaging. Plug the USB-C side into the USB-C port under the left ear-cap of the headphone, and then plug the other end into a USB port on your computer or other devices with a USB port. The indicator light will switch to red while charging. Once the device is fully charged, the LED light will switch off. It takes 2-3 hours to charge the device fully if the battery was completely flat.

Switching On Active Noise Cancelling:

Press and hold the N.C Button for 1 second and the Green LED light will switch on. The N.C function is available on both Wired and Wireless connections.

Switching Off Active Noise Cancelling:

Press and hold the N.C Button for 1 second and the Green LED light will switch off. The N.C functions must be switched off manually.

Switching On Bluetooth:

Press and hold the MFB for approximately 3 seconds and the red and blue LED light will flash quickly. Thereafter a "Power On" tone will be prompted.

Switching Off Bluetooth:

Press and hold the MFB for approximately 3 seconds and then a "Power Off" tone will be prompted.

Pairing:

1. Ensure that your phone or Bluetooth device is switched on.
2. To pair the headphones with a device for the first time switch on the headphones. The headphones will enter pairing mode and the red and blue LED light will flash quickly. To pair the headphones if it was previously paired with another device, ensure that the previously paired device is switched off.
3. Activate the Bluetooth feature on your phone or other Bluetooth devices, and set it to search for Bluetooth devices.
4. Select UL-HPBT03 from the list of devices on your phone or other Bluetooth devices.
5. Once the Headphones are successfully connected a "Connected" tone will be prompted.
The headphones that were previously paired with other devices will automatically connect with the device that's switched on within connection range. Otherwise, the headphones will enter standby mode and the red and blue LED light will flash quickly while alternating. If the headphones do not pair with any device while it is on Bluetooth searching mode/reconnecting mode they will be disconnected automatically after 5 minutes.

Adjusting The Volume:

To turn the volume up/down press the volume +/- key quickly during a call or while listening to music.

Application:

To make and receive calls hands-free and listen to music from a compatible Bluetooth device, the two devices should both be within 10m proximity from each other. The headphones are compliant with Bluetooth Specification 5.0 which supports the following profiles: Headset Profile (HSP) V1.6, Hands-free Profile (HFP) V1.5, Advanced Audio Distribution Profile (A2DP) V1.0, and Audio Video Remote Control Profile (AVRCP) V1.4 input rating 5V DC, 1.0A

Calls:

To make a call, use your mobile phone for dialling when the headphones are connected to it. To answer a call, press the MFB. To reject a call, press and hold the MFB for 1.5 seconds. To end the call, press the MFB quickly.

Activating Voice Assistance:

Press the MFB twice quickly to activate voice Assist

Listening to Music:

To listen to music, connect the headset to the phone or compatible Bluetooth device that support A2DP Bluetooth profile. The available music functions depend on your Bluetooth devices. If you receive or make a call while listening to music, the music will be paused until the call ends.
To play a song, select the song on your Bluetooth device and press Pause/Play on the headset.
To pause or resume the song, press the "Pause/Play" key.
To select the previous song, press and hold the "-" key. To select the next song, press the "+" key.
To increase the volume, press the "+" key and a beep tone will be prompted at maximum volume. To decrease the volume press the "-" key. (Until Mute)

Disconnecting the Headphones:

To disconnect the headphones from your device, switch off the headphones, or disconnect it in the Bluetooth menu of your device.
Reconnecting the Headphones
To reconnect the headphones to your mobile phone of other Bluetooth devices that were paired previously, switch on the headphones or reconnect it in the Bluetooth menu of your device.

Passive Mode:

You can use the UL-HPBT03 as a wired headphone to preserve the battery life. Simply connect one end of the 3.5mm- 3.5mm audio cable to the bottom of the left ear cup to your mp3 player. Inserting an audio cable will automatically disable the wireless function.

Low Battery Warning and Power-Off:

When the device is on and the battery is lower than 3.2V, a "battery low" warning will be prompted every 60 seconds. When the battery Voltage is lower than 3.0V, the headphones will switch off automatically.
